So don't miss this opportunity to enhance your practice and visit one of the most beautiful, unspoiled parts of the world. See you in Vancouver!



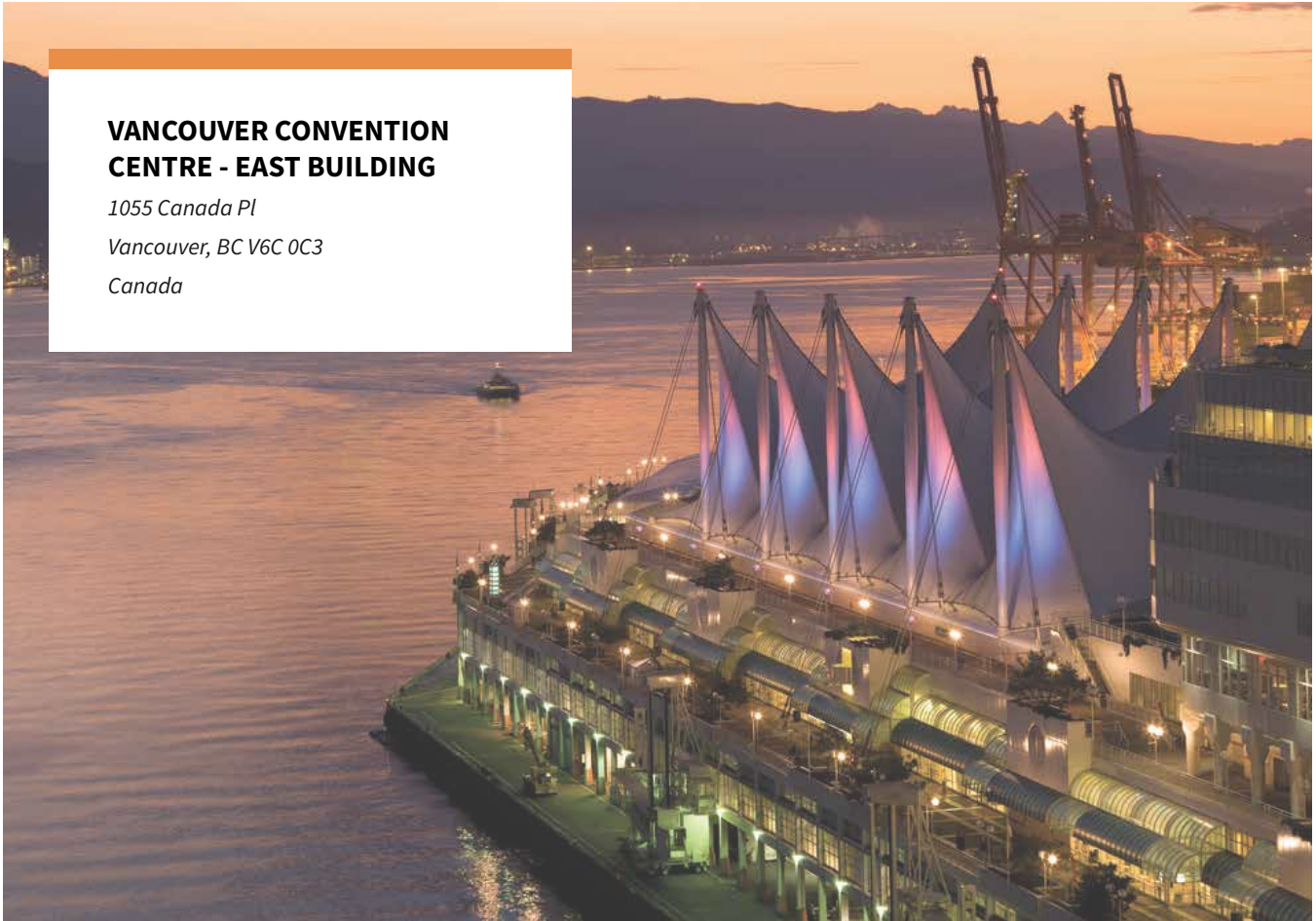

Deadline to register for PROTECT is Wednesday, May 31, 2017

GOAL:

To promote knowledge of obstetricians and midwives worldwide in the management of perineal trauma and episiotomy through structured training with a view to minimising pelvic floor and perineal morbidity associated with childbirth.

OBJECTIVE:

To minimise pelvic floor and perineal morbidity associated with childbirth.

HOW TO REGISTER:

Registrants must meet 2 prerequisite criteria in order to attend this program:

01. Complete and pass theoretical Test Modules on the IUGA website.
(Click here - blue button on the upper right side of the page “Take Test Here”)

02. Attend the OASIS hands-on repair workshop at the IUGA Annual Meeting. (You must register for the meeting + Workshop #1, “Diagnosis and Repair of Acute 3rd and 4th Degree Anal Sphincter Tears” chaired by Drs. Abdul Sultan and Raneer Thakar, Wednesday, August 3; 8am-12pm)

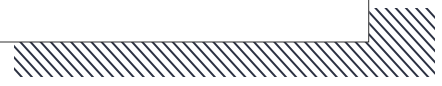

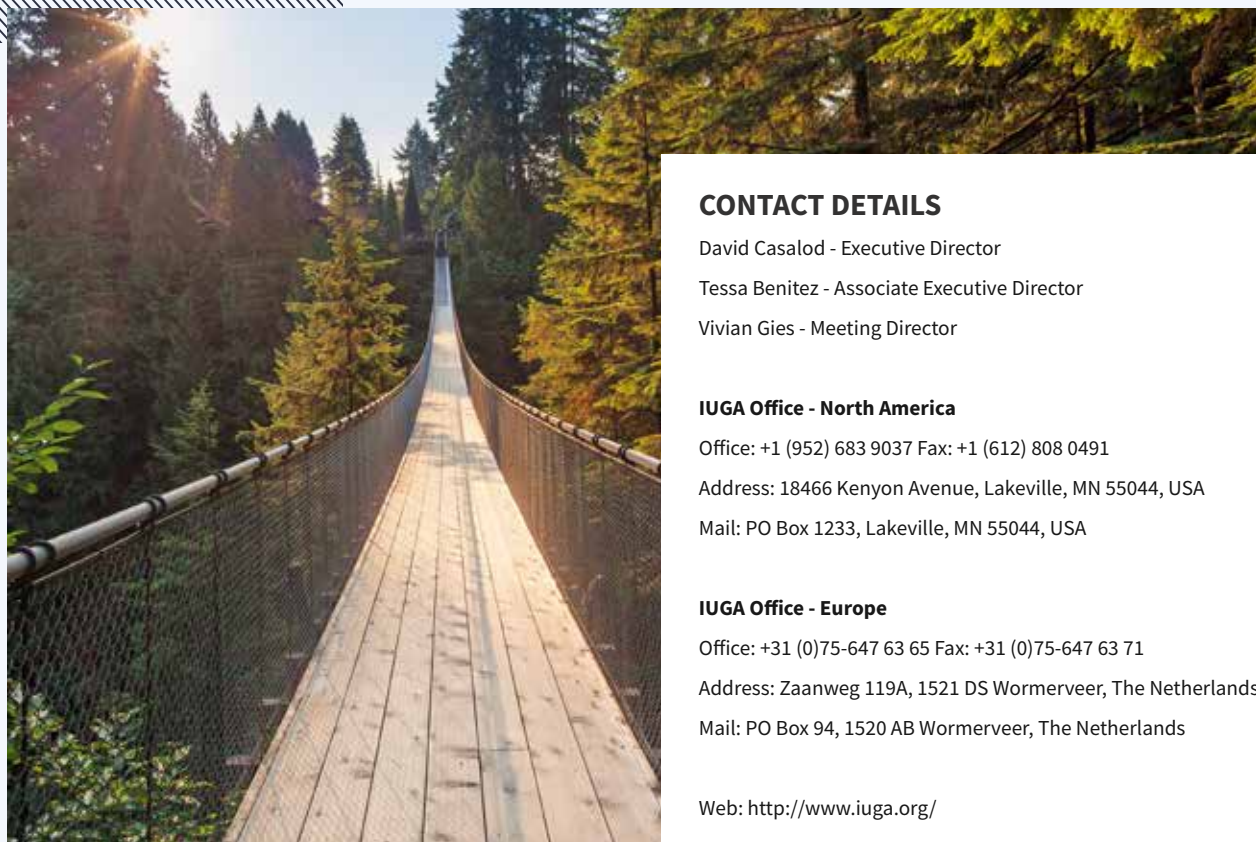
